I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

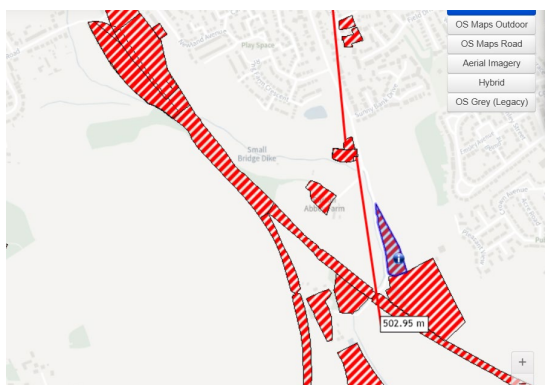
The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Please could you provide copies of the following information related to the landfills within 500 m of the two sites:

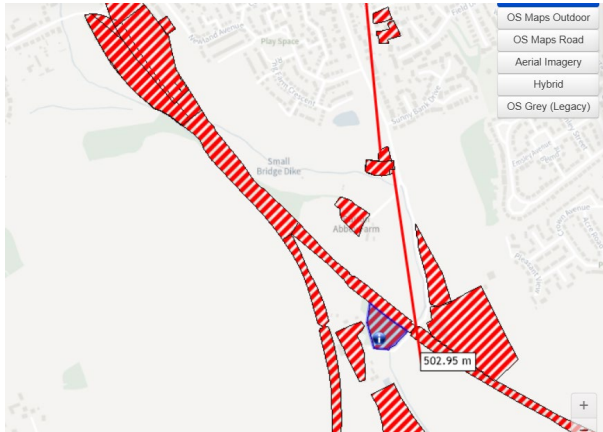
- **The landfill permit(s) and any accompanying surrender note(s)**
- **Drawings showing the extent of the landfill**
- **Details of the construction of the landfill**
- **Drawings showing the layout of any landfill gas control and landfill leachate control systems and any information relating to any ongoing responsibility for these systems**
- **Records of any ground investigation undertaken within the landfill**
- **Records of any monitoring/sampling of landfill gases/leachate**
- **Details of any pollution incidents related to the landfill**
- **Details of any remediation If there is any additional information regarding contamination, pollution incidents and environmental permits (including Part A installations) on Site or for other sites within 250m please can this also be provided.**

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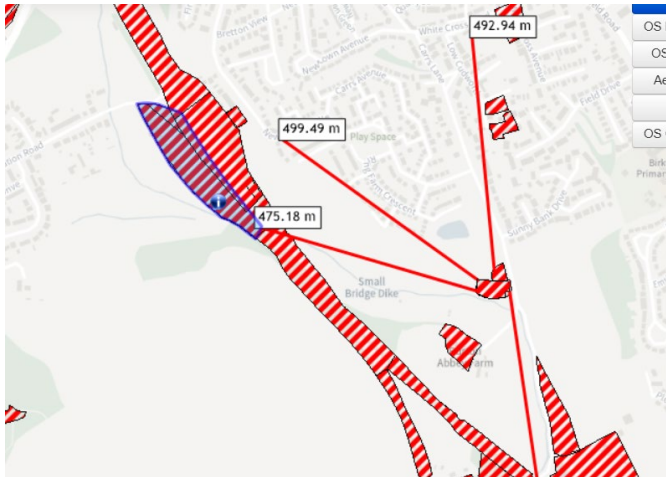
