Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Your questions and my findings are as follows:-

All information, records, plans, correspondence and legal notices in relation to the adoption of Millhouse Lane, (Formally known as Low Millhouse) Millhouse Green, Penistone. The extent of the adopted road and any later extensions to it.

We do not have an actual adoption date of Millhouse Lane as all the roads that were adopted pre 1974 are contained in a combined list with little information.

Millhouse Lane was previously known as Low Millhouse in the Penistone Urban District Council records, adopted for a length of approx. 0.08miles, this was transferred to the South Yorkshire County Council records for a length of 148m and then into the current List of Adopted Highways as Millhouse Lane.

Unfortunately, we do not hold any further records and you have already been provided with images of the documents we hold on file.
