Dear Requester,

Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

1. The total cost to the council of graffiti removal for each of the past three financial years (2022/23, 2023/24, and year-to-date 2024/25).

We are unable to identify the full costs associated with graffiti removal for this time period but we have identified the known costs below which include officer salary costs and the purchase of a new graffiti removal machine in 2023.

2022/2023 – £94,722

2023/2024 – £81,510

2024/2025 - £84,308

Further ongoing costs include the hire of a vehicle (currently £170 per week), cleaning solutions and fluids, officer uniforms and paint for street furniture etc. Other costs would include fuel, insurance, road tax, servicing and machine/vehicle repairs as and when required.

2. The total number of graffiti removal incidents recorded by the council for each of the same years.

We do not hold data in this format, but the following reported cases have been recorded as highest priority which indicates the graffiti was offensive in some way or in a location that was deemed especially harmful.

2022/2023 – 6
2023/2024 – 50
2024/30 September 2025 – 43
