(3) REVIEW OF THE YEARS EVENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN

The Parish Council consulted with residents about provision of a Community venue. A questionnaire was sent to each household and Councillor Berry collated the results. Following on from this a public meeting was held to encourage more discussion, this included use of the recreation field for a wider range of activities (for example the petanque club, fruit tree planting etc.).

Plans for a new accessible path onto the recreation field were started and grant funding successfully applied for.

Parking issues became more noticeable during lockdown and the Council worked with Yorkshire Water and BMBC to identify possible sites for a car park. The Council requested double yellow lines for the Annat Royd Lane/Wellthorne Lane junction where parked cars have obstructed farm and other traffic, this was ruled out due to cost.

Community events working on Sandbeds and Summerford were organised with help from Twiggs. Ingbirchworth community group organised the Community Fun Day which was held on the Council's recreation field, this was well attended and enjoyed.

The Remembrance Day service and Christmas light switch-on events were well attended.
