Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Please treat this as an Freedom of Information/Environmental Information Regulations request.

I would like information about your council's homes and MEES enforcements in relation to climate action for the Council Climate Action Scorecards. This information may be held by a housing department or similar.

In particular, please supply me with information relating to the following questions:

1. What is the energy efficiency rating of the council's homes (managed or owned by the council)?

44.7% of council homes managed by Berneslai Homes have received an EPC rating of C or above.

Please provide either a distribution table with the number of council homes for each EPC rating or the percentage of the council's homes that have received an EPC rating of C or above.

2. What is the number of investigations, enforcement notices and enforcement actions that the council conducted, related to MEES (Minimum Energy Efficiency Standards) in the 2024/25 financial year?

12 investigations were undertaken relating to MEES in the private rented sector during this period, 10 of which resulted in enforcement action including 8 financial penalties issued.

Please provide a breakdown of the number of investigations and enforcements separately. If only some information is available, please provide this information.

I would prefer to receive information in a machine readable format, such as CSV files for data, where possible.
