Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I would like to know information about Barugh Green Park, also known as Barugh Green Recreation Ground, which is situated around the S75 1QH postcode.

Please could you tell me in relation to the playground and it's recent refurbishment:

1. How much did the recent refurbishment including new equipment cost and including breakdown of the refurbishment costs.

Play area up grade - £49,953.72

Refurbishment of Notice board - £1,675

Refurbishment of MUGA - £16,806.88

2. What is the life expectancy of the new equipment.

Dependant on item, however steel work 25yrs/paint work 5yrs/moving parts 1 to 2yrs/installation 1yr.

3. What is the remaining life expectancy of the current equipment aside from the newly installed equipment.

The remaining items are the small spring rides and spinning poles, playground fencing – as above

4. Which company completed the work and were other companies invited to submit tenders.

Totty Signs, Sutcliffe Play & Lightmain LTD – YES

5. Was the work awarded to the most cost conscious tender. If not, why.

Awarded on Cost & Play value

I'd also like to know, in relation to the football pitch:

1. Which football team/s currently host football matches on the grounds and how much revenue this generates to cover the cost of the maintenance of this football pitch and surrounding ground.

The ground is currently not hired out for Football

2. What are the current season pitch fees for football teams leading a pitch for the season from BMBC.
