I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I am writing under the Freedom of Information Act to request information relating to the availability of drinking water fountains. I would like to request:

- 1) The number of drinking water fountains in your area for the years 2015 and 2025, broken down as follows:**
 - a. Total number of all drinking water fountains.**
 - b. Total number of drinking water fountains maintained by the council.**
 - c. Total number of drinking water fountains maintained by public and private partnerships.**
 - d. Total number of drinking water fountains maintained by private initiatives.**
- 2) The postcode of the location of all the drinking water fountains in your area in the year 2025.**

The Council has identified no drinking water fountains within its estate. Please note that the Council only holds information relating to assets it owns, manages or regulates. It does not hold a record of all drinking water fountains within the borough.
