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Barnsley Council does not have a separate food waste collection service.

Please note that the method for collating missed waste collection data was revised from the start of the last financial year to align with the APSE (Association for Public Service Excellence) definition. Under this definition, a missed collection is recorded when a scheduled collection does not occur on the prescribed day (regardless of whether it was reported by a resident), and the resident was not informed in writing of any change to the arrangements.

Prior to this change, our records only included missed collections reported by residents. They did not account for collections that were missed due to operational issues such as vehicle breakdowns, adverse weather, or access problems. As a result, figures from before the last financial year are not directly comparable and would not provide a true reflection of missed collection performance under the current reporting criteria.
