**Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

**I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please provide the full gritting and winter maintenance logs for the section of road outside Threeways, Oxspring, S36 8YB, including the tight right hand bend, for the period 1 January 2026 to 31 January 2026.**

**Specifically, I am requesting:**

- **Dates and times when this route was scheduled to be gritted**

- **Dates and times when this route was actually gritted**
- **The type and quantity of treatment applied**
- **Any records of route completion, vehicle tracker data or operator logs relating to this location**
- **Any reports, complaints or internal notes concerning ice, snow or road safety issues on this section of road during January 2026** If this section of road forms part of a designated primary gritting route, please also confirm the name/number of that route and provide the relevant section of the winter service plan that applies to it.

I can confirm that the area in your request does form part of our Primary gritting network and the route name for this location is A3/P3.

Dates and times of commencement of gritting operations, treatment type and the tracker information times for treatment can be found in the attached document.

No specific reports of ice, snow or road safety issues were received by the duty coordinators or via the Highways Maintenance inbox during the specified date range.

Section 2, headed Carriageway Salting (Gritting) gives details of our Winter Service objectives in relation to the precautionary gritting of Primary routes and also includes a link to the interactive map which shows all 9 primary routes across the borough. Section 5 of the policy gives further information on our gritting operations.
