Re: Request for Information – Environmental Information Regulations 2004

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

The number of planning applications received by your authority between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2025 relating to residential care homes, specifically involving a change of use from Use Class C3 (dwelling houses) to Use Class C2 (residential institutions).

**If possible, please provide this information broken down by year.
For clarity, residential care homes typically fall under Use Class C2, and a material change of use from C3 to C2 generally requires planning permission.**

If it is easier, a summary table would be appreciated.

Under Regulation 6(1)(b) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, the Council is not obliged to comply with a request to provide information in a specific format where the information is already publicly available and easily accessible in another form or format.
