Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I require the following information under the Freedom of Information Act / Environmental Information Regulations:

1. Inspection Records: Copies of all safety inspections carried out on Grange Lane/Cundy Cross between 20th December 2025 and 21st January 2026.

The Area Inspector carried out an inspection on 21st January 2026 for pothole requests on Grange Lane Cundy Cross. The Area Inspector also placed repairs for the following location on:

- 07/01/2026 Grange Lane river bridge
- 12/01/2026 Grange Lane river bridge
- 21/01/2026 Grange Lane river bridge

2. Report Logs: The date and time the defect in question was first reported to the Council (either by a member of the public or a Council employee).

The Service became aware of the initial pothole at 09:39 on 20th January 2026.

3. Repair Timestamps: The exact time the "Out of Hours" team was dispatched and the time the repair was completed on 21st January.

The Highways Standby operative was contacted on 21st January at 18:49 to undertake another, further repair to the pothole. The actual time this further repair is not recorded but was completed with an hour of the initial call.
