Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Your questions and my findings are as follows:-

We require the pre-admission numbers for all FS2 (Foundation Stage 2) cohorts that primary schools will be admitting in September 2025, and what the school's PAN (limit) is. For example, Churchfield has a PAN of 60, and is currently admitting 60 pupils. The area we require this for is all primary schools in Cudworth, Grimethorpe, Brierley and within a 3 mile circular radius of S70 3ES

Please find below the full list of Primary schools located within a 3 mile circular radius of S70 3ES. The allocation figures are correct as of 2nd July 2025. The schools in Cudworth, Grimethorpe and Brierley have been highlighted.
