Use of Private Investigators Dear [Barnsley Council / Berneslai Homes] FOI Team, Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to request the following information:

- 1. Please provide details of any occasions where your organisation has engaged or instructed private investigators / private detective agencies since 1st January 2015. For each case, please provide: The date(s) of instruction. The reason/purpose for hiring the investigator. The agency/company name and services contracted. The total cost incurred (broken down by year). Whether the instruction was authorised internally or by an external legal team. Copies of any relevant policies, procedures, or guidance documents used to justify or govern the use of private investigators.
- 2. Please confirm if any staff members, tenants, or former staff members have ever been the subject of such investigations, and if so, the total number of cases. (No personal identifiers are requested, just aggregate figures.)
- 3. Please also confirm if members of the public, campaigners, activists, journalists, political opponents, councillors, or candidates for election have ever been the subject of such investigations since 1st January 2015. Again, no personal identifiers are requested, only aggregate figures and the reason given for authorisation.

Please be advised that, following a thorough review of our records, Barnsley Council and Berneslai Homes have not engaged or instructed private investigators or private detective agencies since 1 January 2015.
