One factor that can't be overlooked is your family history, as you are **2.5x more likely to get prostate cancer if your father or brother has been diagnosed with it.** Early prostate cancer doesn't usually come with any symptoms. That's why knowing your risk is so important, as the sooner you catch it, the easier it is to treat.
