Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

1. **Can I make a Freedom of Information request for all of the documented evidence you hold pertaining to collection of items from my property, 36 Wentworth Street, S70 5UN.**

We removed one bed frame & settee on the 24th December 2024 at a cost of £26.00

2. **Can I also make a further Fol request for the average cost to Barnsley Council for collection of a bulky waste item and the average cost to Barnsley Council of an escalated complaint.**

We do not hold the information on the cost of removing bulky waste items from properties. Commercial Services receive a budget to remove bulky waste, bin deliveries and commercial waste.

In regards to the average cost to escalate a complaint. The information you have requested is not held or recorded and to create this it is likely to exceed the time limit outlined with the Act.
