Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

UNISON requests the following information through a formal freedom of information act request:

 A gender breakdown for all roles within the council. This must include the number of people in each job role and the percentage of those who are male or female.

Please see attached spreadsheet

 A list of departments within the council, aside from waste management, which benefit from a variation of task and finish highlighting specific job roles which benefit from the practice.

None exist.

- Any collective agreements relating to task and finish.

None exist.

 Records of the start and finish times of waste management loaders and drivers, this should be a sample including data for two weeks per year, going back 6 years.

The council does not hold this information.

- Sample tachograph and weighbridge data including the first and final loads of the day in waste management, this sample data should include data for two weeks per year, going back 6 years

The council does not hold 'sample data' in such a format as requested. For a request to be valid under Section 8 of the FOI act it must specify in writing the information requested. The request is effectively giving the council the choice of what data to include and as such is not deemed to be valid under FOI.

It should also be noted that the council only retains 2 years of tachograph/weighbridge data.

If you are unhappy with the way the Directorate has handled your request, you may ask for an internal review. Please clearly mark your correspondence 'Complaint' and address it to:
