**Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

**I would like to request some information from you under the Freedom of Information Act Data concerning the use of fixed penalty and penalty charge notices in your area.**

**I would like this information broken down by month from the latest available data stretching back to January 2022.**

**I would like the data laid out in a CSV and split up into the categories of FPNs i.e the specific number of FPNs handed out for littering, fly-tipping, dog fouling, fly posting and graffiti.**

File attached. We only have this data broken down into years. We do not have a complete picture for 2025 so we have only provided until the end of December 2024.

**I would also like to get the numbers of civil enforcement officers and ASB enforcement officers employed by the council for each month over the same period.**

As discussed with the information team, Civil Enforcement implies Parking. So this will need to be clarified. For ASB enforcement: We have 44 Officers whose role involves dealing with ASB, however none of those have roles that solely deal with ASB.

**If the data exists, I would also like to know how many of these officers get assigned to street patrols per month.**
