**THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF BARNSELY  
(BARNSELY SOUTH EAST AREA) (TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION)  
ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT NO. 17) ORDER 2026**

The Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Barnsley South East Area) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2018 shall have effect as though:-

(i) In Schedule 1 of the Order (Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time) there were included the following:-

**KIRK BALK  
Hoyland**

**South West side** – from its junction with the north western kerb line of West Street in a north western direction for a distance of 15 metres

**North East side** – from its junction with the north western kerb line of West Street in a north westerly direction to a point 15 metres north of its junction with the north western kerb line of Longfields Crescent

**WEST STREET  
Hoyland**

**North West side** – from its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Kirk Balk in a north easterly direction for a distance of 38 metres

**LONGFIELDS CRESCENT  
Hoyland**

**Both sides** – from its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Kirk Balk in a north easterly direction for a distance of 37 metres

(ii) In Schedule 1 of the Order (Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time) the following are to be deleted and hereby revoked:-

**KIRK BALK  
Hoyland**

**West side** – from its junction with West Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 8 metres

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of March 2026 and may be cited as "The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Barnsley South East Area) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2018 (Amendment No.17) Order 2026".
