THIS ORDER is made by Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council under section 53(2) (b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the former West Riding of Yorkshire requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3) (c) (i) of the Act namely the discovery by the Council of evidence which, when considered with all other relevant evidence available to it shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path and that other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

THE authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which this Order relates

THE Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council hereby order that:


1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 12 January 2026.



Bear left briefly crossing the stone inlet via the steps and stone slab bridge, then right continuing northwards gradually moving away from the riverbank over the slight rise and back down to join Hunshelf bridleway 18 and Hunshelf footpath 18 at the bridge, stepping stones and ford, near Cherry Tree Cottages.
