Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to request information regarding the seizure of illegal/counterfeit tobacco and cigarettes within the jurisdiction of Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council and subsequent prosecutions initiated by the trading standards officers.

Specifically, I request the following information for each of the past five years, starting from January 1, 2019:

Seizure Data:

1. The total quantity of illegal/counterfeit tobacco (e.g., number of cigarettes, kilograms of hand-rolling tobacco, or other relevant measures) seized by trading standards officers each year.
