

## Barnsley 10k charity criteria 2026

<b>Eligibility</b>	
The company must be a registered charity within the Barnsley area.	
If above is not met, the charity should have a clear mission that aligns with community health, wellness or social causes that benefits an individual from Barnsley.	
<b>Purchase limits</b>	
Each charitable organisation can purchase a maximum of 25 places.	
Additional places may be requested but will be subject to availability and approval.	
<b>Discounts and pricing</b>	
Charitable organisations will receive a 50% discount on general entry fees.	
A commitment to purchase these places is binding and must be made in full aligning with your request for entries. Places are not guaranteed until payment has been made.	
<b>Fundraising commitment</b>	
Each participant must commit to raising a minimum of £100 for the charity.	
Charities must provide a fundraising plan and regular updates on progress.	
<b>Promotion and branding</b>	
Charities are encouraged to promote their participation in the event through their own channels.	
The Barnsley 10k can provide logos and messaging towards Barnsley's physical activity movement campaign 'What's Your Move'.	
<b>Participant information</b>	
Charities must provide a list of participants and their contact details by the end of <b>February</b> for race t shirts and medals to be ordered.	
Charities are responsible for coordinating their participants on the day of the event. Participants numbers will be available to collect from Race HQ alongside our general entries.	
<b>Post-event reporting</b>	
Charities must submit a post-event report detailing the funds raised and the impact of the event on their cause.
