Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Please can you tell me, in 2025, the total number of households (inc individuals) who were placed in temporary accommodation (including 'interim', 'emergency' or any other formulation for non-permanent accommodation) by the council.

- 374 households/618 individuals were placed in interim or temporary accommodation in 2025.

Can you please tell me in 2025 the number of refugee households (inc individuals) who were placed in temporary accommodation by the council.

- 16 households/42 individuals were placed in interim or temporary accommodation in 2025 and recorded as having Refugee Status.
