I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

- **How many disputes over Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plans has the council had taken to Tribunal in the years:**
 - 2025 (to June) - 43
 - 2024 - 74
 - 2023 - 40
 - 2022 - 42
- **How much money has the council spent on legal fees on these disputes, broken down by year.**

Data on tribunal costs is not recorded separately so we are unable to provide this information.

- **How many disputes that went to Tribunal were later conceded by the council. Data for 2022 and 2023 years is not recorded. Please note that 2025 data relates only to those closed so far in 2025 and is subject to change.**
