The Council flies three flags all year round:

- The Union Flag
- St George's Cross Flag
- Barnsley Council Flag

A Flag and Lighting Policy for Barnsley Town Hall is being put forward to Full Council for consideration on Thursday 16 July 2026. This will detail which flags are proposed to be flown from the Town Hall going forward.
