From 01/09/2020 to 22/03/2023 the ratepayer was an individual trading as Tanlines Studio

From 22/03/2023 to 30/09/2024 the ratepayer was Tanlines Rotherham Limited

We hold the name of the individual liable from 2020-2023 but cannot disclose this without receiving a formal request on letterheaded paper (can be sent electronically) citing the reason for the request and the exemption the information is requested under.
