- (i) At least 2 months warning of the outdoor event taking place to be given in writing to the Licensing Authority and South Yorkshire Police
- (ii) One month prior to the outdoor event taking place, a meeting to be held to discuss policies, procedures and the event itself with the following being in attendance:
 - Organiser
 - Licensee
 - Door security firm
 - Local Safer Neighbourhood Team
 - Licensing Section
 - Fire Service
 - Health and Safety Officer
 - Any other Interested Party
- (iii) SIA registered door staff to be employed with both male and female representatives, on a ratio of 1 to every 100 people present
- (iv) A drugs policy to be produced in writing to the Police one month prior to the outdoor event taking place
- (iv) A Challenge 25 Scheme to be put in place, with posters being clearly visible throughout the venue
- (v) A 'No search - No entry' policy to be adopted with everyone entering the site being searched (including DJ's, performers and VIP guests) with this policy to be noted on all tickets
- (vi) A 'Drugs Drop Box' policy to be adopted. A drugs box to be made available for anyone to dispose of their drugs prior to entry and being searched. Also a drugs box to be provided for any drugs seized by door staff
- (vii) Everybody (including DJ's and performers) returning to their vehicles after entry has been gained to be researched upon re-entry
- (ix) A log of all drugs seized to be produced upon request
- (x) In the event of drugs being found on an individual they be retained and the Police contacted.

- (xii) Tickets to state that there is the right to refuse entry and retain tickets to any person (this will cover refusal of entry to anyone who is intoxicated or under the influence of drugs or any other substance)
- (xiii) Double skinned security fencing to be provided with security at vulnerable sections with regular patrols taking place
- (xiv) Staffing at toilet sites and regular walking through of the site every 30 minutes with a detailed log being kept and produced upon request
- (xv) The Licensee or the DPS to be present and on site throughout the event
- (xvi) A personal licence holder be present for each licensed bar area
- (xvii) No noise to be audible at the façade of the nearest noise sensitive premises
- (xviii) All live, amplified music to be played through a noise limiting device located in an area which cannot be adjusted by any individuals
- (xix) Any speakers located externally to be facing in a westerly direction with a solid screen to the rear of the speakers and amplifiers

Subject to conditions 1 and 2, the premises at all times shall operate subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) No noise to be audible at the façade at the nearest noise sensitive premises.
- (ii) All live, amplified music to be played through a noise limiting device located in an area which cannot be adjusted by any individuals.
- (iii) Any speakers located externally to be facing in a westerly direction with a solid screen to the rear of the speakers and amplifiers.
- (iv) No regulated entertainment in external areas after 21:00 hours save for as permitted pursuant to condition 1 of Annex 3.

External entertainment after 21:00 hours to be restricted to background music only.
