Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding the published claim that Barnsley town centre received over 9.18 million visits in the financial year 2024/25. Please provide the following:

A breakdown of how the 9.18 million footfall figure was calculated, including:

The devices or technologies used (e.g. sensors, cameras, mobile data) Number and location of all footfall counters used Whether figures include repeat visits, double-counting, or pass-through traffic Whether vehicle passengers or public transport alightings are included

- Footfall in Barnsley Town Centre is measured using data from mobile devices, such as GPS and app usage. Devices need to be within a catchment for five minutes to be counted. Visitors with several devices on their person are counted once. Vehicular movement are discounted meaning passengers are not counted. Visitors travelling by public transport are included if they alight the vehicle and spend more than five minutes within a catchment. Footfall counts are refreshed daily. This method is more accurate than sensors that count movement. Sensors are not used to count footfall in Barnsley Town Centre.

A monthly footfall breakdown for Barnsley town centre from April 2024 to March 2025.

- This data represents the catchment area of 'Barnsley Central.'

- Barnsley Council contracts the service from Fetch Analytics, previously Visitor Insights.

Clarification on whether these visits equate to individual people or total sensor activations (i.e., visit count methodology).

- The visit count methodology is described above.

Confirmation of whether the footfall figure includes people entering/leaving: The Glass Works Barnsley Markets Barnsley Interchange The Alhambra Shopping Centre

- The Glass Works, Barnsley Market, Barnsley Interchange, and the Alhambra Shopping Centre are within the catchment area of 'Barnsley Central.'
