- We have provided data for 2024/25 and 2025/26. Data for the other years requested isn't available within the constraints of the FOI request.
- The data for 2026/27 to date is not available as we don't forecast/budget at client level.

In addition:

- Our current supported living model operates with a core structure. In 24/25 core hours were in 23 properties supporting 93 people, in 25/26 the core structure was in 23 properties supporting 97 people. Core hours are not attributable to individuals and are therefore not included in the data provided.
