Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I wondered if I could ask for a freedom of information request please.

I am basically wondering what the procedure is for cleaning up hazardous materials, all parts of the process.

Specifically large diesel spillages on public pavements.

Large diesel spillages are usually found on the highway rather than public pavements. After receiving the initial call this is communicated to a Team Leader who will respond. Depending on the severity of the spillage we would treat with spill dry and follow up with hand sweeping or small sweeper. If the spillage is large, we would fill a gritter with sand to treat the spillage and follow up with a large sweeper.
